



Challenge

A regional energy company needed assistance with the design of its monthly utility bills. Customers found the existing bill to be challenging to read and unnecessarily long. However, the company had no internal expertise with document composition or information design and approached the Venture $Clear^{TM}$ Communications Practice team for help.

Solution
